Distributional effects of globalization are a crucial concern in the public debate. The question how globalization affects the distribution of income within countries is also a classical question in academia dating back to the famous work by Stolper and Samuelson (1941). In the last few years we saw a growing literature that focuses on distributional effects of globalization in models with firm and / or worker heterogeneity thereby providing a richer picture of inequality.

The goal of this seminar is to gain a better understanding of this important topic by identifying

- the **channels** through which globalization affects inequality
- the strategies how to **quantify** the distributional effects of globalization
- the differences between the distributional effects of **trade** and **offshoring**
- the possibilities to **redistribute** gains from trade

Students participating in this seminar should have a solid background in international trade. They should be interested in both theoretical and empirical work, and be familiar with the respective concepts and methods.

Participants will write a term paper and give a presentation. **Presentations** are scheduled to take place on **June 24**, **2021** (afternoon) **and June 25**, **2021** (whole day). If necessary we are also going to use **June 23**, **2021**.

A mandatory (!) first meeting will take place on April 22, 2021 at 2.15-3.45 p.m.. The specific topics on which participants will work will be announced in this meeting.
