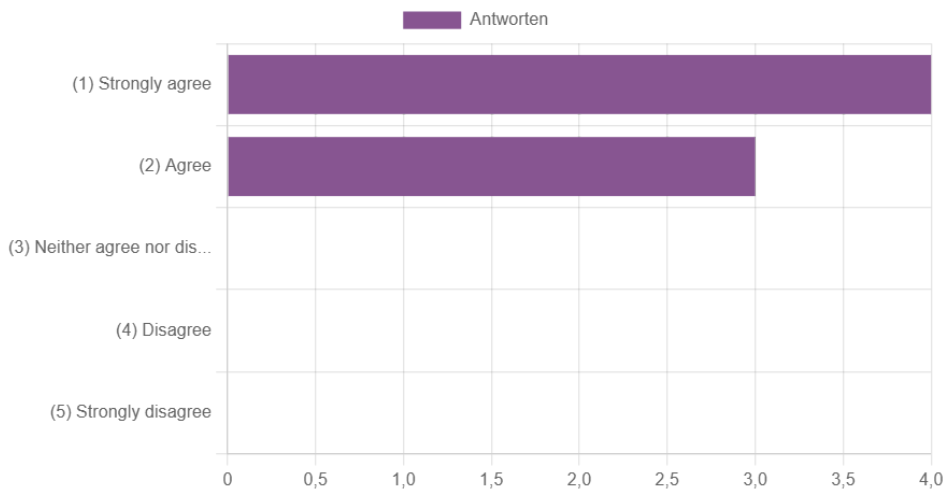

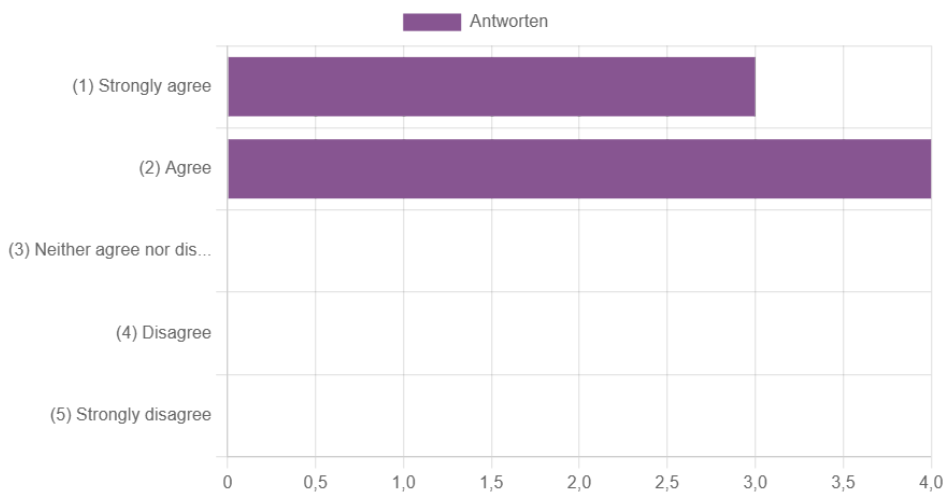

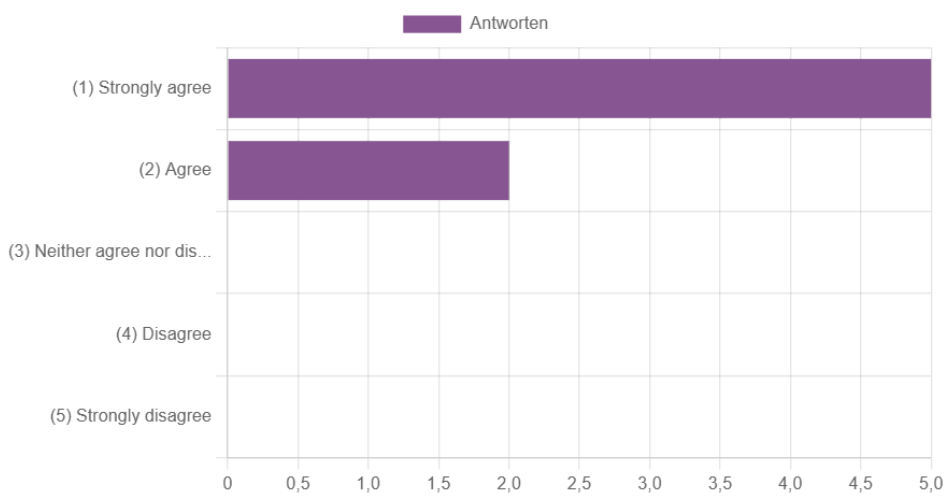

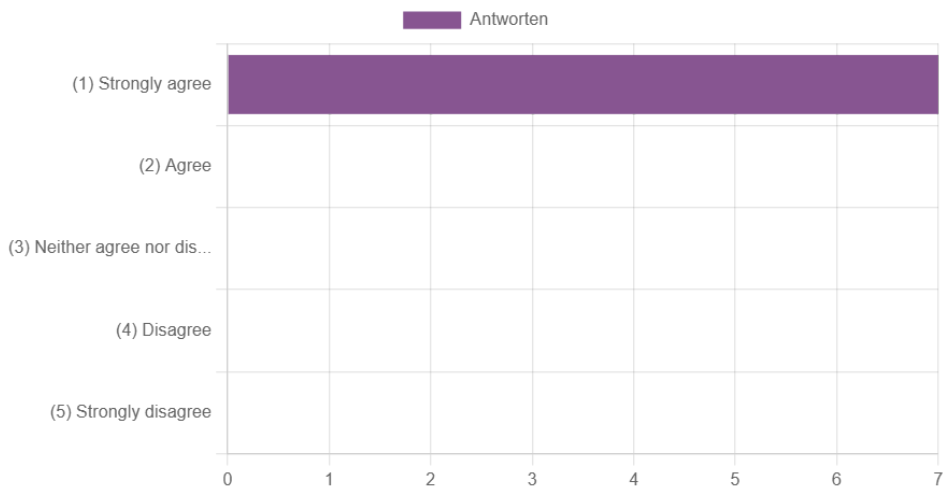

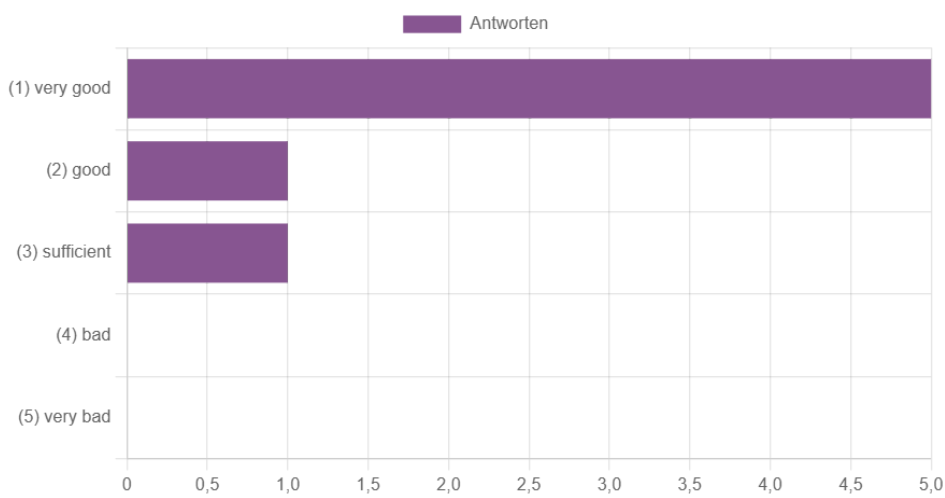

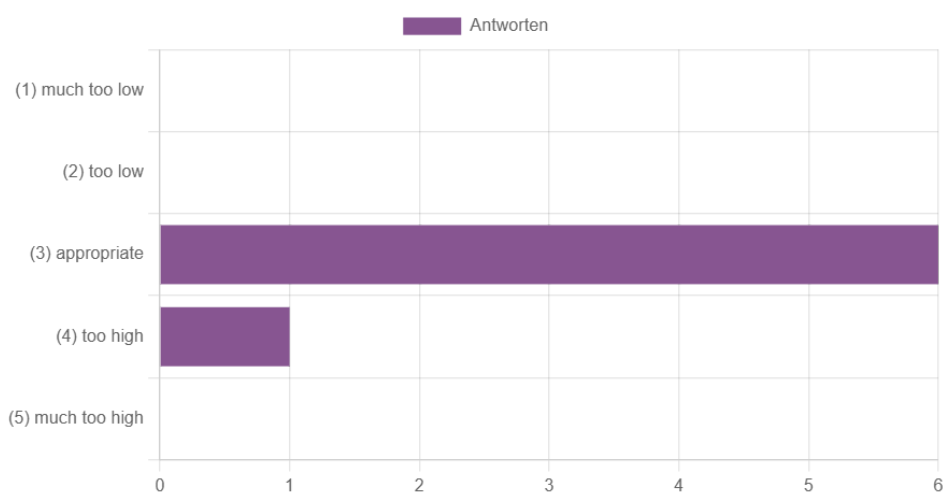

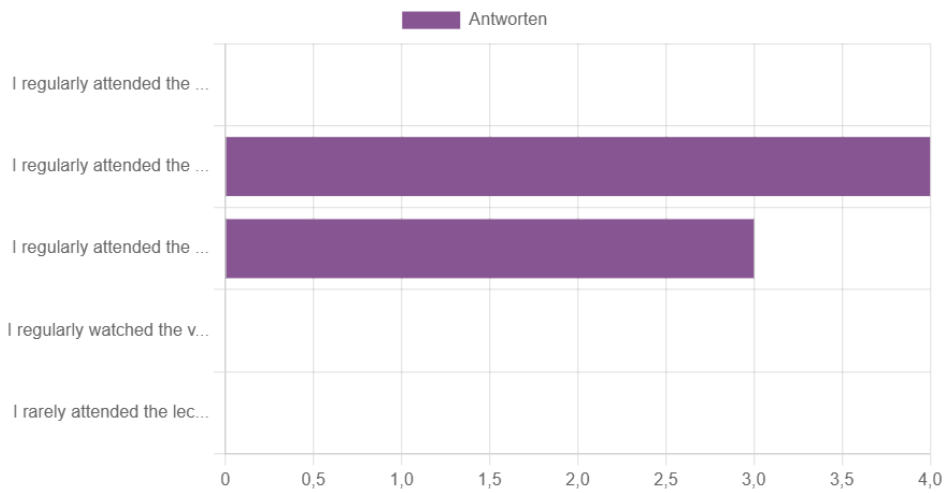

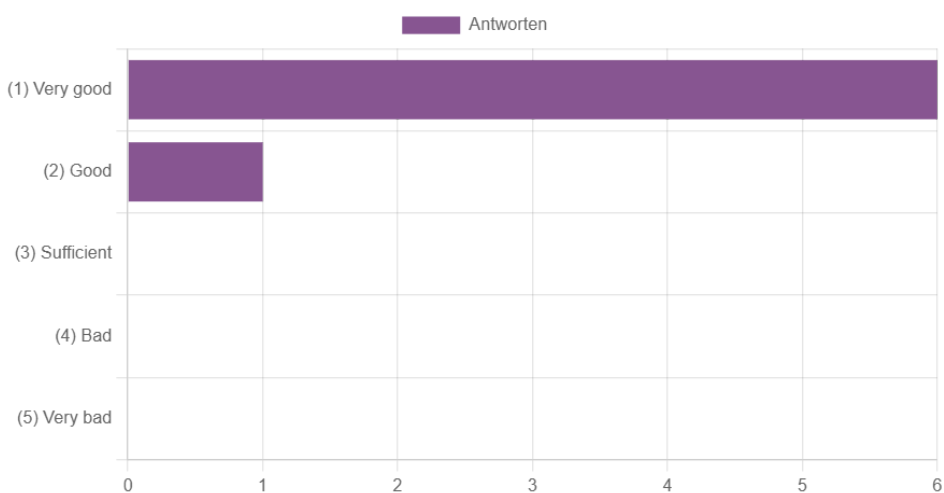

### 13. What should be improved?

The speed of the lecture is a bit too fast for me, sometimes it is hard to follow where exactly we are. Making thematic instead of time cuts would be valuable for me, e.g. not stopping the lecture in the middle of a topic but maybe a bit earlier or later when one topic is concluded. Makes it easier to get back into it.

- Too many formulas and calculations, which in turn make understanding more difficult in some places, especially in the chapter on exchange rates.
